Sapphire

Sapphire metal tile roofing is a beautiful roofing material, suitable for most roof applications. They combine traditional looks with the latest technology and can be used on residential and commercial buildings.

Sapphire panels are made from steel coils, galvanized on both sides, with several protective layers to ensures durability. Steel is one of the most light-weight roofing materials, reducing the need for heavy supports. This is particularly important for re-roofing old buildings, since light-weight metal panels do not require reinforcing the supporting structures. One roofing square (10' x 10') of metal roof weighs 96 lb., about 10 times lighter than clay tiles.



A wide range of KYNAR 500® colors ensure you'll find something that fits your building design. Tile panels are cut to the inch, reducing waste and keeping costs down.


Sapphire installation goes quickly due to the larger tile size. Sapphire carries a 50 year warranty.

The right style of metal roofing will complement any home's architecture, from Victorian to contemporary.










Trims help protect against wind and weather as well as finish out the look of the roof. They are formed from the same material and color as the tile panels. Trim shown below are available in either standard dimensions or customized based on preferences and specific needs. Available profiles are made of G90 galvanized steel sheets with lengths - typically in 8' lengths (though 10' is also available).

We offer SAPPHIRE panels in 16 colors in Kynar 500® or Hylar 5000® coatings that comply with Energy Star guidelines and are LEED compliant, ensuring projects are energy efficient and sustainable.

Kynar/Hylar is a 70% formulations of polyvinylidine fluoride (PVDF) resin - long proven as the best paint in the metal roofing industry.

One of the secrets of PVDF's superior durability lies in the molecular structure of this resin. This unique carbon/fluorine bond is the key to its unsurpassed thermal, chemical and ultraviolet resistance properties. This system demonstrates remarkable resistance to weathering, fading, cracking and chalking.

Cool Colors

Sapphire colors are available in reflective pigments. These special pigments are designed to reflect infrared energy while still absorbing visible light energy, thus appearing as the same color yet staying cooler.

When reflective paints are used on Sapphire metal roofing, the result is a sustainable building material that can lower air conditioning costs and reduce peak energy demand, thus lowering costs while protecting natural resources and help reduce pollution.
